BIOGRAPHY

Graduating with high promising grades (1987) from the China Conservatory of Music, Tang Xiaoping was accepted into Central Opera Symphony Orchestra as their Principal Clarinetist. In 1988, Tang Xiaoping was cordially invited to tour with the China Youth Symphony Orchestra to Switzerland and Italy. In 1991, he was specially invited by the "China Central People Broadcasting Station" to do an interview that is nationally broadcasted of his achievement and life in the "Half an hour lunch interview" segment.

In 1994, with his accomplished results, Tang Xiaoping was accepted into Boston Conservatory of Music to study under the tutelage of Dr. Ethan Sloane, meanwhile holding the position of Principal Clarinetist in the orchestra. The following year, Tang Xiaoping was honored to receive the "Outstanding Student Scholarship" and won the "Dean Scholarship" of Boston Conservatory of Music.

In 1995, Tang Xiaoping joined the Singapore Symphony Orchestra and in 1996, he successfully performed the famous repertoire of Amadeus Wolfgang Mozart - Clarinet Concerto in A Major" with the orchestra.

As a well accomplished and widely recognized musician, Tang Xiao Ping was invited to perform in the "International Chinese New Year Festival" in Shanghai, China and in the Beijing Opera House in Beijing, China. In Singapore, he has participated in different Singapore Arts Festivals performing as soloist with the ensembles and orchestra.

In 2015 June, Tang Xiao Ping was specially invited by the Harbin Symphony Orchestra to work with renowned conductor, Rylor Vladimir to perform as a soloist in which he successfully performed to great acclaims, the Carl Von Weber - Clarinet Concertino and also the Franz Krommer - Double Clarinet Concerto in Eb Major.
