Ryan Wong is a musician who teaches, performs, writes, arranges, records, and produces.

Upon graduating with a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Music from the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts in 2010, Ryan has gone on to record, arrange, and produce for many songwriters, artists, radio stations, schools & organizations.

He has recorded, mixed, and mastered “The Oriental Moon”, an instrumental album by Liang Wen Fu, Jiu Jian, & Ding Yi Music Company; Bedok North Secondary School’s school song, consisting of their symphonic band & choir; produced Telok Kurau Primary School’s 85th anniversary album; and produced a Mandarin album by local songwriter 九木 (jiu mu).

He has also worked closely with UFM 100.3 radio station in arranging a 2012 Christmas song, a 2013 station song, a 2013 Chinese New Year medley, and co-written an original song for Chinese New Year with them in 2015.

Ryan was the music arranger for Innamorati (Wei Yi) The Musical, which was based around many of Eric Moo’s hit songs.

He was the session guitarist for the music of the tele-movie “Two Boys and a Mermaid”, and was invited to be the recording engineer for the 2nd Voices of Asia, International Choir Festival and Competition in Malaysia in 2014.

Most recently, he has arranged music for Holy Innocent’s Primary School, Holy Innocent’s High Sch, and 97.2FM DJ Wallace Ang.
